The Spriggy Prepaid Card and Parent Wallet are issued by Indue Ltd (ABN 97 087 822 464, AFSL 320204) (**Indue**).

Spriggy Schools is also the issuer of the Spriggy Schools product. Spriggy Schools issues the Spriggy Schools product in accordance with *ASIC Corporations (Non-cash Payment Facilities) Instrument 2016/211*.

About the licensee

Rivva is the holder of Australian Financial Services Licence, no. 513762 (AFS Licence). Rivva distributes and promotes the Spriggy Prepaid Card and Parent Wallet products which are issued by Indue.

Spriggy Schools is authorised to provide financial services on Rivva's behalf in relation to the Spriggy Prepaid Card and Parent Wallet. These financial services are provided on behalf of Rivva and not on your behalf.

Rivva is responsible for those financial services provided by Spriggy Schools as its authorised representative and has authorised Spriggy Schools to distribute this FSG.

Rivva and Spriggy Schools are related entities (Spriggy Schools is a wholly owned subsidiary of Rivva). Indue is not a related entity of Rivva or Spriggy Schools.

What kinds of financial products and services can Spriggy Schools provide?

The Spriggy Prepaid Card and Parent Wallet are facilities for making non-cash payments and, as such, are financial products. These products are issued by Indue.

As an authorised representative of Rivva, Spriggy Schools is authorised by Rivva under the Rivva AFS Licence to provide general financial product advice for, and deal in a financial product by:

- arranging for a person to issue, apply for, acquire, vary or dispose of non-cash payment products; and
- applying for, acquiring, varying or disposing of on behalf of another person:
 - basic deposit products;
 - deposit products other than basic deposit products; and
 - non-cash payment products;

to retail and wholesale clients.

Rivva acts on its own behalf when Spriggy Schools provides financial services as an authorised representative of Rivva.

Spriggy Schools is not authorised to provide (and Rivva itself does not provide) personal advice about financial products. As Spriggy Schools provides general advice only, which isn't tailored to your personal objectives, financial situation or needs, you should consider whether it's appropriate for you and consider obtaining independent financial advice before making any financial decision.

Spriggy group

Spriggy Schools is part of the Spriggy group, which includes (without limitation) Rivva, Spriggy Invest Pty Ltd (ABN 21 639 671 926, AR 1283837) (**Spriggy Invest**), and Rivva Mobile Pty Ltd (ABN 35 674 423 333) (**Rivva Mobile**).

Spriggy Invest is the promoter of an investment fund known as Spriggy Invest ARSN 643 467 270 (**Fund**). Spriggy Invest is an authorised representative of Cache Investment Management Pty Ltd ACN 624 306 430, AFSL 514 360 (**Cache**). Cache (RE Services) Ltd (ACN 616 465 671, AFSL 494886) (Cache RE) is the responsible entity of the Fund and the issuer of units in the Fund. The Fund is managed on behalf of Cache RE by Cache. Rivva distributes and promotes the Spriggy Prepaid Card and Parent Wallet products under its AFS Licence. The Spriggy Prepaid Card and Parent Wallet products are issued by Indue. Rivva may distribute or promote other financial products which are issued by other product issuers from time to time. The details of these issuers will be set out in the relevant PDS.

Product issuers

The Spriggy Prepaid Card and Parent Wallet products are issued by Indue. Indue is an authorised deposit-taking institution for the purposes of the Banking Act 1959.

Remuneration, commissions, fees or other benefits

Indue Prepaid Card and Parent Wallet

Rivva charges an annual fee for its services in connection with the Spriggy Prepaid Card and Parent Wallet issued by Indue. These fees are set out below:

Who the fee applies to	Annual Spriggy Membership Fee (\$AUD)
Parents on the One Child Pricing Tier	\$60 per Parent (with up to one (1) Child)
Parents on the Multiple Children Pricing Tier	\$78 per Parent (with between two (2) and six (6) Children)

Also, Rivva is paid fees by Indue for other services it provides to Indue in connection with the Spriggy Prepaid Card and Parent Wallet, these are set out below:

Fee	Fee (\$AUD)
Cancellation Fee	A Cancellation Fee of up to \$10 in certain circumstances where a Parent's or Additional Parent User's Parent Wallet is cancelled.
Prepaid Card Replacement Fee	\$10 per replacement Prepaid Card (except where a replacement Prepaid Card is issued upon expiry of a Prepaid Card in accordance with the Product Terms and Conditions).

Indue will pass on a portion of the interest that is earned on the value that is stored on the Parent Wallet and Prepaid Cards from time to time to Rivva. The amount of interest that Rivva will receive is calculated as X% of the value stored on the Parent Wallet and Prepaid Cards, where "X" is equal to the official cash rate determined by the Reserve Bank of Australia minus 0.25%. Interest is calculated daily.
